This course will provide training in the skills necessary to respond to a diving emergency. It is designed specifically for public safety dive teams and professional divers. It is the Dive Medical Technician course without chamber operations. Medical and non-medical dive team members as well as non-divers interested in public safety diving are encouraged to attend.

Topics Include: Fitness for Diving, Physics and Physiology of Diving, Decompression Sickness, Cerebral Arterial Gas Embolism, Barotrauma, Contaminated Water, and more....

Skill Stations: Patient Assessment, Neurological Assessment, Airway Management, Chest Decompression, Trauma.

Scenarios will be conducted utilizing patient simulation mannequins and each other. You will perform patient assessments on the mannequin, perform needle decompression, provide wound care and hemorrhage control with tourniquets and hemostatic gauze.
